

- C. Concluding sentence- Summarize your points and explain the relevance of the evidence in relation to the main thesis statement.

III. Body Paragraph 2

- A. Second main point- In a sentence or two write your second target point
- B. Evidence Provide credible evidence that supports your idea. The evidence should be strong and relevant to your target point (Quote sources and provide proper citations)
- C. Concluding sentence- Summarize your points and explain the relevance of the evidence in relation to the main thesis statement.
